In regards to Terry Ermoian and PURE FREEDOM MINISTRY, gosh, where do I begin?..!'ve known Terry for 25 + years, but I wasn't a member of his ministry until I hit rock bottom oh, over a decade ago. I was visited by the FBI in regards to inappropriate images from 13 months before while doing research and information gathering for a business situation. Needless to say, it lead to spam on my e-mails, inappropriate materials in my file sharing account and after a time, I too was hooked on viewing, deleting, reviewing and deleting those images.

When I called Terry to ask for help, of course, it was too late for legal help, but what I needed was spiritual, inspirational help and I received it from Terry from that day until today.. Unyielding support. During my 7 year incarceration Terry wrote me and I wrote him weekly..He and a few friends and family members saw me through,

What Terrys' ministries brings to me and other men is a safe haven to understand we are not alone in the battle of temptation, pornography, lust and illicit behavior our world brings to use hourly along with a methodology to combat the evils surrounding us, PLUS a true sense of family, fellowship and accountability. Not only to our group, but to ourselves, our family, our friends and to God. He has taught us that we going to be confronted / challenged by Satin and that we are NEVER alone in a time of need, either through our pledge of faith/committement, by contact with him, a group member or GOD himself.

He encourages us to be who we are, what we are and why we are ..without question, but to know that we are always under fire to do wrong from evil forces and that we need to be strong, alert and resilient and he has shown us the way through all these years by his teaching and his own testimony and actions.

I personally would have not had the strength to endure my incarceration without his continual support and encouragement. During that time I completed several business related college courses, religious/faith courses and taught myself a new career field I now am a part of today. No one knows the struggles each of us endure while being incarcerated, but Terry understood he was our anchor, our link, to the outside world and without his support we may easily slip back into our old ways once we return to civilization without his support, his love and his caring attitude. Thank God for Terry.
